Who are we?

A Social Care Team within the East Riding of Yorkshire Council supporting those with a range of disabilities – including Learning Disabilities, Autism and physical disabilities

We are made up of Social Workers, Care Coordinators and Care Officers and cover the whole of the East Riding

Who do we support?

We support young people and adults with a range of disabilities, including learning disabilities, Autism and physical disabilities

You can be referred for support from one of our Care Officers from the age of 14. We will usually start a Care and Support Assessment with you at about the age of 17

How to refer

What do we do?

Transition planning from children's services to adult services and preparation for independence for young people and adults

Care and Support Assessments to assess eligibility for adult social care – looking at areas such as Managing Personal Hygiene, Maintaining a home environment, accessing the community and maintaining personal relationships

Care and Support Plans

Independent Travel Training and Travel Pass Assessments

Support with finding day services and care provisions

Support with finding Independent Supported Living Settings (ISL's), shared accommodation and residential settings

Support with commissioning and setting up a direct payment package

Life skills observations and evaluations

Community connecting – helping people to know what's in their local area and helping people link to social opportunities in their community

Attend Education, Health and Care Plan Reviews

Work with other professionals from health and education

We work under the Care Act 2014 and the Mental Capacity Act 2005
