This Notice must be published in a LOCAL NEWSPAPER circulating IN THE VICINITY OF THE PREMISES.

IF THERE IS NO LOCAL NEWSPAPER, the Notice may be published in a CIRCULAR OR SIMILAR DOCUMENT circulating IN THE VICINITY OF THE PREMISES.

The Notice must be published on AT LEAST ONE OCCASION during the period of TEN WORKING DAYS starting on the day after the day on which the application was given to the Licensing Authority (East Riding Of Yorkshire Council)

It is for the applicant to decide in which local newspaper to publish this Notice, but the Licensing Authority believes that a reasonable interpretation of 'a local newspaper' in the relevant Regulation would include publication in the Hull Daily Mail or a local free press paper. Applicants are advised to contact the Licensing Authority for clarification.

Representations by a Responsible Authority or an Relevant Person must be made during a period of 28 consecutive days starting on the day after the day on which the application is given to the Licensing Authority.
