Notice of adoption of the Sustainable Transport Supplementary Planning Document (SPD)

On 31 May 2016 East Riding of Yorkshire Council adopted the Sustainable Transport Supplementary Planning Document (SPD). The adopted SPD provides further guidance on the application of Policy S8 'Connecting people and places' and EC4 'Enhancing sustainable transport' of the East Riding Local Plan Strategy Document and will be an important material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
