Consultation on the Submission Allerthorpe Neighbourhood Plan 2019-2034
The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 Regulation 16 – 'Publicising a plan proposal'

Allerthorpe Parish Council has prepared its Submission Allerthorpe Neighbourhood Plan and submitted it to East Riding of Yorkshire Council. The council must now publicise the plan proposal and accompanying documents for a six week period of public consultation and seek comments. This represents the final document prepared by the parish council and, following the conclusion of this six week period of public consultation, the plan will be submitted with any comments to an independent examiner to undertake an examination.

The consultation period commences on Friday 11 January 2019 and comments on the Submission Allerthorpe Neighbourhood Plan should be received on or before Friday 22 February 2019.
