

A164/B1232 Willerby Roundabout Improvements

Need for the Project

Why is the project being done?

It is a planning condition that local housing developers fund improvements at the junction to ease congestion. East Riding of Yorkshire Council are progressing the scheme on their behalf.

Who is paying for the project and what is the cost?

The overall estimated cost of the scheme is £1.3m. Developers' contributions are expected to total around half of this with the remainder funded by the Council. The cost is shared because not all future traffic growth that the scheme is designed to mitigate arises from the housing developments.



Why is the existing arrangement so congested?

At present the heavy westbound flow on the A164 provides little opportunity to enter the roundabout from Willerby and only one lane is available for right turners which form the majority of traffic from the Willerby direction. This is exacerbated by the lack of traffic turning right from the A164 eastbound which blocks the westbound flow and creates entry opportunities. Also, only one straight ahead lane is available on the A164 westbound approach making this flow almost constant at peak times.
